Community

An exceptional educational institution, Christian Academy of Guatemala (CAG) is situated in San Cristobal, Mixco, on the west side of Guatemala City. The spacious 5-acre campus provides a secure and nurturing environment for students from Kindergarten to 12th grade. The student population is culturally diverse and comprises 53% Hispanic/Latino, 24% Asian, 21% White, and 2% Black/African American, making our school a reflection of the diverse economic foundation of the developing area.

School

Christian Academy of Guatemala is a comprehensive four-year private high school enrolling 49 students in grades 9–12. The school opened in the fall of 1974. Christian Academy of Guatemala is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Cognia and holds membership with the College Board, National Honor Society, and Quill and Scroll International Honorary Society. CAG is a member school of the Child Safety & Protection Network (CSPN).

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a traditional seven-period day schedule. Students must take a minimum of 6 credits each school year from 9th to 11th grade. For graduation, a student must earn a minimum of 25 CAG-approved credits.

These AP® courses are offered: AP English Language & Composition, AP English Literature & Composition, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Statistics, AP® Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics C: Mechanics, AP Physics 1, AP Environmental Science, AP Spanish Language and Culture, AP Spanish Literature and Culture, AP Microeconomics, AP Macroeconomics, AP Human Geography, AP US Government and Politics, AP World History Modern, AP European History, AP US History, AP Psychology, AP Computer Science – A, AP Computer Science Principles. An Honor class is offered in Algebra II.



Grading

C.A.G. uses the following 4-point system:

Students must achieve a final semester grade of 70% or higher in a class to receive a Pass.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

GPA is the recognized number system for coursework. A student's GPA is used to determine his/her Honor Society eligibility, Honor Roll status, and class rank. GPA is computed using the above quality points. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 25 credits is required for graduation. In addition, each student must complete a senior project for a graduation requirement. AP classes and Honors classes are weighted by one point. Grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is computed in January and May.
